James engages with individuals on a personal level, and his presence enhances the experience for everyone, making him a valuable part of the team and a true companion in every sense of the word.

Q: What do you like most about being a Companion for Artisans' Bank?

A: "Being a Companion gives me purpose each day, and the people here at the Milford Branch feel like family to me. This place is my home and provides comfort when I need it," said Jim.

At 78 years old, James, better known as Jim, occasionally finds himself contemplating retirement, but the vibrant joy he experiences in his daily work keeps drawing him back. Each day, he eagerly engages with his customers, building meaningful connections that enrich both his life and theirs. The laughter, stories, and warmth exchanged in those interactions make his job feel less like work and more like a rewarding experience. Despite the thought of stepping away, James remains dedicated to his role, relishing the sense of purpose and community that his job provides.









Q: Part of why you were chosen this month is your past military experience, can you share that with us?

A: Jim enlisted in the Navy in 1965, motivated by a sense of duty and a desire for adventure. After successfully completing his initial training, which included physical preparation and technical instruction, he was trained to carry an M-16 rifle. To his knowledge, his boot camp class was the only one to receive training on this weapon.

He chose to further his skills by taking additional classes in specialized fields. This dedication to his professional development would serve him well during his service.

His journey began with an exhilarating deployment aboard the USS Rushmore, a well-equipped amphibious dock landing ship, as it set sail for the Mediterranean Sea. Over the course of more than a year, he dedicated himself to serving on this ship, engaging in a variety of missions that included training

exercises and multinational naval operations. Each day brought new challenges and experiences, shaping his skills and deepening his commitment to his fellow service members and the mission at hand.

Jim was then deployed to Vietnam aboard the USS Springfield for almost a year.

Upon returning from his deployment in Vietnam, Jim continued his commitment to military service by joining the Reserves, where he served for an additional two years. During this time, he remained stationed domestically and did not undertake any new overseas assignments. In total, Jim dedicated six years to his military career, encompassing both his active duty in Vietnam and his subsequent service as a reservist. This experience greatly shaped his perspective and experiences throughout his life.

Q: Is the Military part of your family history?

A: The military has played a vital role in Jim's family history, with roots tracing back to the historic Battle of Gettysburg. One of his ancestors fought valiantly during the battle, and their name is honored on a plaque situated within the hallowed grounds of the battlefield. Through his volunteer efforts, he helps to organize events and spread awareness about the importance of remembering and honoring those who have served in the armed forces.

A : Outside of being a companion, Jim passionately tends to his garden, knowing that even in its current disarray, he has the power to cultivate beauty and restore life.
